CN and America in Bloom Announce 2016 Community Greening Project Completion for Independence, Louisiana

COLUMBUS, OHIO: CN and America in Bloom today announced that Independence, Louisiana will celebrate completion of the its first ever green space initiative made possible in part through a matching grant of \$12,290 from the CN EcoConnexions *From the Ground Up* program in the United States.

Mayor Michael A. Ragusa and the Town of Independence will host a celebratory event with a walking tour at the Town Hall on Thursday, June 2, 2016 at 9:00am to acknowledge the project organizers, community volunteers, staff, and most importantly CN EcoConnexions and America in Bloom, who have supported the project from its inception both financially and educationally. Marvin Miller, America in Bloom past president, and Bill Hahn of America in Bloom will be in attendance as well as a representative from CN. The event is open to the public.

Thanks to the grant project, Highway 51 in downtown Independence sports an array of beautiful plant beds lining the railroad tracks, creating pleasing aesthetics.

"Without assistance from America in Bloom and CN, our town would have simply received 'just another grant' but because of their continued guidance, assistance, and mentorship we have developed a community project that encourages a sense of community pride and cohesiveness," Mayor Ragusa stated. "The Town of Independence is a quaint town with lots to offer. Our new plant beds added a nice touch to the downtown corridor. We appreciate CN EcoConnexions and American in Bloom for providing us with this grant opportunity."

CN EcoConnexions *From the Ground Up*, now in its third year in the U.S., provides opportunities for CN and the communities along its rail network to work together towards shared goals of environmental stewardship.
